On the Beach

You're invited!

Join us to discover what creatures live in the nearshore habitat at the mouth of Clear Creek in Dyes Inlet.

We'll gather on the beach at Old Mill Park on Bucklin Hill Road in Silverdale. On site parking is very limited. Park at the Clear Creek Interpretive Center and walk to the beach.

Previous beach seines have found juvenile salmonids and the forage fish they feed on, such as herring, surf smelt and sand lances.

The crew deploys a floating seine net which volunteers on the beach pull in to shore. All fish are released as quickly as possible after they're identified, counted, and measured.
